A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE APPLICATION OF THE ISABELA CITY HEALTH CLINICAL LABORATORY FOR ACCREDITATION AS A SCREENING DRUG TESTING LABORATORY WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH, ADOPTING THE MINIMUM REQUIRED PAYMENT FOR SCREENING DRUG TESTS, AND PROMOTING A DRUG-FREE WORKPLACE IN THE CITY OF ISABELA.

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 9165, otherwise known as the Comprehensive Dangerous Act of 2002, mandates the establishment and accreditation of drug testing laboratories to aid in prevention, control, and eradication of illegal drugs in the country;

WHEREAS, in compliance to with the Department of Health (DOH) and the Health Facilities and Services Regulatory Bureau (HFSRB) Guidelines, the Isabela City Health Clinical Laboratory intends to establish a Screening Drug Testing Laboratory (SDTL);

WHEREAS, the operation of a STDL within the Isabela City Health Office will significantly enhance the City's efforts in supporting a drug-free workplace and community, and will ensure access to affordable, accurate, and timely drug testing services;

WHEREAS, the Anti-Drug Abuse Council (ADAC) of Isabela City has manifested its support for the establishment of the SDTL as part of its comprehensive local anti-drug strategy;

WHEREAS, the City Government of Isabela is committed to promoting and sustaining a drug-free workplace by implementing regular and random drug testing among its employees, in accordance with the Civil Service and DOH policies;

WHEREAS, the designation of the unit through Resolution No. 24-7002, duly approved by the Sangguniang Panlungsod on October 24, 2024 under the RHU I Ambulance Unit was found necessary in place of Isabela Super Health Center, as the latter was not yet operational at that time;

WHEREAS, the operational requirements of the SDTL shall be supported by the City Government of Isabela, through the City Health Office;

WHEREAS, the Local Health Board (LHB) o Isabela City expressed the need to adopt the minimum cost for screening drug tests in accordance with the guidelines of the DOH to ensure affordability and accessibility to the general public.

NOW, WHEREFORE, upon motion of Councilor Asan Al-Ameen S. Camlian, duly seconded by members present,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Isabela, Province of Basilan, supports the application of the Isabela City Health Clinical Laboratory for accreditation as a screening drug testing laboratory with the Department of Health, adopting the minimum required payment for screening drug tests, and promoting a drug-free workplace in the City of Isabela.




